On-street parking

We continue to have challenges with improper street parking. There was a collision recently in the cul-de-sac, due to a vehicle trying to get around two cars parked on either side of the road, blocking passage.

Rule highlights:

- A vehicle must be 15 feet bumper-to-bumper from another vehicle when parked on the street.
- No street parking in the cul-de-sac. Emergency vehicles need to be able to turn around.
- Do not park on the street within 100 feet of the subdivision's entrance. It makes it dangerous to pull into or out of the subdivision.
- You must park in the direction of traffic.
- Driveways are not to be blocked for any reason. This includes across the street. Residents have raised issues backing out of their driveways because of a car across from them.



- Also, mailboxes or fire hydrants must not be blocked. For vehicles parked on the street, their bumpers must be 10 feet from mailboxes or fire hydrants.
- No RVs, trailers, boats, commercial vehicles, etc. can be parked on the street.
